



East Riding 4x4 Club price list and guide lines for Helmsley and other club events

Note: - The club membership year runs from the 1st January through to the 31st December.

Admin reserve the right to change the following at any time due to COVID restrictions or for any other reason to ensure safe operation of East Riding 4x4 club.

'The club' refers to East Riding 4x4 Club.

Shows & camping.

- 1) Show camping & show fees attendance/night/adult will be confirmed by the committee based on site fees as advised by the event organiser.
- 2) Prices for BBQ's and extras at shows or camping etc. will be advised prior to each event.
- 3) Shows & other events, arrival time will be advised by the committee in advance.
- 4) All adults attending any club event must be paid club members,

Helmsley for 2021 :-

- 1) Is set at £50/joint members & £35/single members for the weekend & this includes the driving activities.
- 2) Day visitor, is £20/adult & this includes the driving activities.
- 3) No one is to enter the field before 4pm on the Friday.
- 4) Gate to field shall be closed at all times on entering and exiting field, even if found open.
- 5) All motorised vehicles shall be taxed, insured and MOT'd or age exceptions as advised by DVLA.
- 6) No Quads, scooters or motorcycles etc.
- 7) All drivers shall hold a full UK driving licence.
- 8) Speed on site in all areas is restricted to 10 MPH.
- 9) Seat belts shall be worn at all times while driving onsite & includes all passengers.
- 10) No one is allowed to use the Hills or trials area unless a member of the committee is on site and agreeable.
- 11) No vehicles are to be driven after alcohol has been consumed, you can drink or drive but not both!
- 12) Use of generators, these shall be switched off between the hours of 2200 & 0800 and are to be located away from the general camp area, vehicle engines shall be shut down at 2200hrs even if being used for heating purposes, any person driving onto site late should be considerate of others & keep engine noise to an absolute minimum. All music shall be switched off at 2200 hours.
- 13) All dogs shall be controlled at all times by an adult and kept on a lead.
- 14) All children shall be supervised at all times by an adult when on site, not to be near the hill trial area when in use by vehicles unless closely supervised by an adult who is not driving or marshalling.
- 15) Field is to be kept clean at all times and **all your own rubbish is to be taken away with you at the end of the event. A bin is provided by the club however this is for small items & should not be used to empty your own bins into!**



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Green lanning.

- 1) Drivers must be paid members of the club.
- 2) All motorised vehicles must be taxed, insured and MOT'd or age exceptions as advised by DVLA.
- 3) No Quads, scooters or motorcycles etc.
- 4) All drivers must hold a full UK driving licence.
- 5) Green lanes are classed as 'roads' and all rules which apply to use of vehicles on 'roads' apply to use on green lanes!
- 6) All dogs shall be controlled at all times by an adult and kept on a lead.
- 7) All children shall be supervised at all times by an adult.
- 8) Where possible groups should be a maximum of 5 vehicles.
- 9) Group leaders are to complete the form 'Group register of vehicles and personnel on a green lane event' at the start of the day, these are to be returned to admin for retention. These forms are available on request from a member of the admin team.
- 10) All gates must be left as found unless obviously incorrect! (caution/think)
- 11) CB radio is the preferred method of communication by the club.
- 12) The CB channel for the day is normally the 'date' if there is any interference or poor reception the group leader will advise an alternative channel to use for the day.
- 13) If you start out with a group and you wish to leave the group for any reason YOU must inform the leader of your intentions before leaving.
- 14) If you break down on a green lane, the group will help if possible to rectify the issue, if this is beyond the ability of the group members for any reason then the group will endeavour to recover the vehicle & occupants to a tarmac road with mobile phone coverage in order that the individual can arrange for their own recovery to take over.
- 15) The club recommends that all vehicles (or drivers) are covered by a third party recovery service provider.

Definition of family/joint membership is, Partners, married couples, father & son, mother & daughter, or similar restricted to 2 adults. (For father & son/mother & daughter etc. the electoral address shall be the same)

The above is to assist the club in ensuring safe events and are subject to change at the discretion of the committee at any time to improve safety and/or efficiency!
